D. SPECIES OF CONSERVATION CONCERN

<u>Listed species</u>

None.

Other species

No species are known to be of conservation concern based upon the limited information available. Conservation status will be more thoroughly assessed as more information is gathered.

Schendyla dentata. An elusive, synanthropic species with only one record in Scotland, in Edinburgh. Otherwise only in south England.

Strigamia crassipes. A woodland species in south England with only a few old records in central Scotland.

Geophilus gracilis. An intertidal/splash-zone species known only from the west coast.

Geophilus proximus. A single specimen from Unst is the only British record. It occurs in Norway and it is quite likely to have been introduced to Scotland from there.

Lithobius lucifugus. In the British Isles known only from Edinburgh – Cramond church-yard and adjacent woodland – and in a glass-house on Mull, both recorded after 1989.
