D. SPECIES OF CONSERVATION CONCERN

Listed species

No species currently listed as of concern. Unclear of likelihood of Ixodida being included as species of conservation concern due to their notoriety as being potential vectors of disease.

Other species

Argas reflexus⁺, Ixodes acuminatus⁺, Ixodes caledonicus, Ixodes unicavatus, Ixodes ventalloi⁺ and Carios maritimus (previously Ornithodoros maritimus)⁺ could be considered potential candidates with fewer than thirty records recorded in the last British Distribution Atlas. However, caution is advised as the lack of records may reflect more their host preference and therefore limited access to retrieve them rather than their fragile existence.
